### Online Enrolment Forms

We are excited to announce we will be rolling out the new Online Enrolment System from today, Monday, 26 October 2020. A link to begin an online enrolment application will be available via the "Enrolment" section of the school website.

The Online Enrolment System is designed to provide flexibility for our parents to submit an enrolment application online and at the time that best suits you. The application can be accessed on all browsers and mobile devices including iOS and Android.

The online application process is currently restricted to:

- \* Enrolments into **local** schools only
- \* Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- \* Children who live in NSW.

We offer our support and encourage you to complete your application to enroll online. If, however, you do not feel comfortable completing an application online, a paper copy will be available for collection from the front office or can be downloaded from the Department's [going to a public school site](#).

### History of the School

The original site suggested by residents had been passed over in favour of one up the main road a mile or so, as suggested by Inspector Maynard. The new site, of 2 acres, was part of a larger 142-acre block owned by Mrs M. Christie. Mrs Christie was not prepared to sell the 2 acres for school purposes so the Department of Education decided to resume the land, a time-consuming task. However, by February 1881, the site for the school had been resumed, much to the pleasure of George Weakley who had been complaining of delay, and of overcrowding at the denominational school.

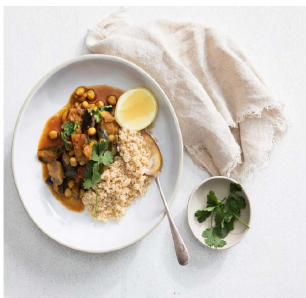
