Xmas Cards

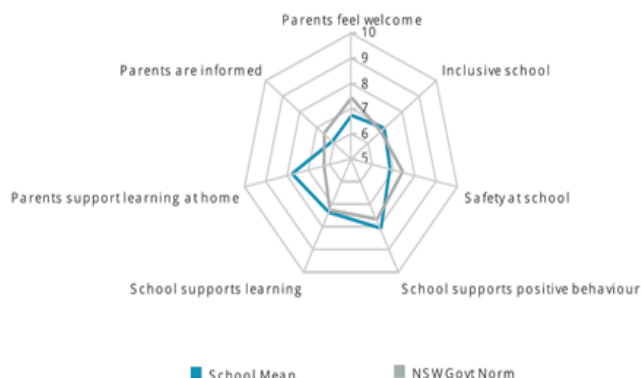
A reminder that we ask students not to hand out Xmas cards until after the 1st December and no candy is to included when giving peers Xmas cards. Thanks for your co-operation.

History of the School

Samuel Viles continued to teach in the old denominational school building until 21 September 1883 when he took possession of the new schoolroom. The new brick buildings consisted of a schoolroom, 34 by 18 feet, in which most of the teaching took place, and a small classroom, about 14 by 11 feet, which was designed as a withdrawal area for religious instruction by visiting clergy.

Not Returning in 2021?

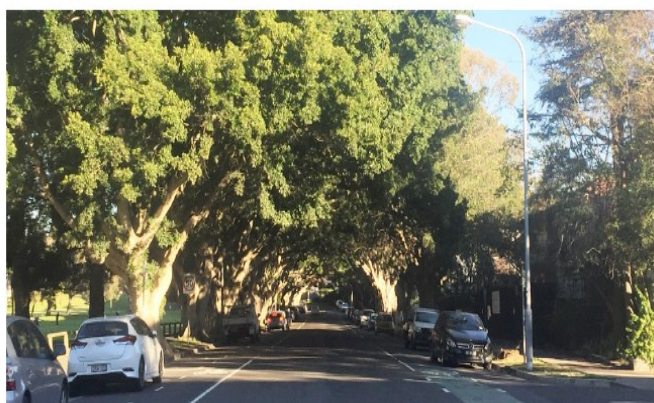
We will start to organise classes soon for 2021. If you are moving and will not be returning in 2021. please advise the office as soon as possible.

KEEP THE LUNCHBOX COOL

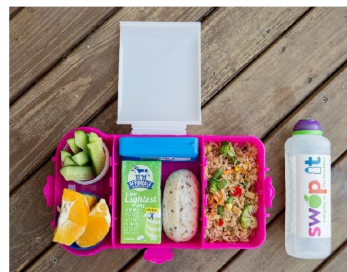
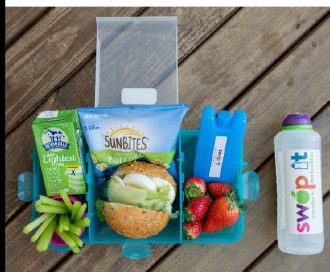
As the weather warms up it is important to keep the lunchbox cool so that food stays safe to eat.
