New COVID Guidelines

The Department of Education released their latest guidelines last week. I have highlighted below the restrictions which most affect our families at Beresfield. Students presenting as unwell

If a student exhibits cold and flu-like symptoms whilst at school they will be sent to sick bay and a parent/caregiver must come and collect the student as soon as possible. The student will be required to be tested for COVID-19 and can only return to school when

- the testing is negative and school is provided with the results; and
- they have recovered from the illness and are symptom free

Please note this is the same for students who do not attend school due to flu-like symptoms and is a mandate from the Department of Education.

It is important that when responding to the daily text you give details as to what symptoms the student has and if they have been COVID tested, not just sick.

If the text does not have enough detail your class teacher will ring home for more details.



When the negative COVID test result is received please forward the email or screenshot of the text result to the school email address before they return to school. Beresfield-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au

Parent Visitors

Parents will be asked not to go beyond the office during the school day. If you are dropping off a child late or collecting early, we will ask you to wait in the foyer. This will not change the drop off arrangements from 8:30-9am, or the pick up arrangements at 3pm.

Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should be tested.

Symptoms include:



fever



cough



sore throat



difficulty breathing



loss of smell



loss of taste

Other reported symptoms of COVID-19 include:

fatigue, runny nose, muscle pain, joint pain, nausea/vomiting, diarrhoea, loss of appetite or other flu symptoms.

Drop Off in the morning

Pick up in the afternoon

Parents of primary students, please stay outside the gates to pick up. Parents of K-2 and Support students, please don't enter the school grounds in the afternoon till 2.55pm and observe social distancing guidelines.
