Aboriginal Education

With Vicki Winters on board as our dedicated Aboriginal Education teacher each Monday and Tuesday, things are a-happening!

We have a Deadly Brekky starting today and continuing each Monday and Tuesday morning from 8.30–9.00am in the Special Purpose room. Aboriginal students will be offered a healthy breakfast and given an opportunity to talk to their peers, and share stories to assist in starting their day well.

Tomorrow we start fortnightly Aboriginal dance classes. Students will be taught by Emily Punu, a well-renowned dance teacher from the local area.

Tomorrow we also spruce up our Bush Area and Yarning Circle. Students will be spending some time in the bush area learning about the plants and significance of the bush area. They may do some light gardening and should bring some gardening gloves if possible.

Finally we are offering Art Sessions for Aboriginal students who have selected art as an area they would like to work on in Goalhub.

History of the School

Previous to our school being established in 1883, the only school in the Beresfield area was a denominational school - the Hexham Church of England School. It was possible for denominational schools to convert to public schools, provided the Council of Education was agreeable. In so doing, local communities were relieved of all costs of the school

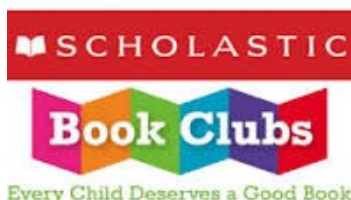
