#### **COVID** Restrictions for schools

Beresfield PS is on **Level 3 plus** restrictions. This means:

• Students will be in cohort groups, reducing the number of students they mix with



- Masks are mandatory for all staff indoors, and strongly recommended indoors for primary students.
- All staff members and essential visitors are required to be fully vaccinated.
- Out of School Hours Care will still operate.
- Non-essential visitors are not permitted on school sites.
- Parents should not enter school gates.
- No community use of school facilities
- No assemblies, transition to school activities, excursions or scripture.

#### **Food and Drink**


The canteen will operate each week this term from Tuesday to <sup>e</sup>



Friday only. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the canteen will be operating on a **ORDER ONLY** basis, for both

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lunch and recess. There will be no over the counter sales.

Please provide food for your child on Mondays.

Please provide a water bottle. Students will be filling water bottles from bubblers rather than using the bubbler directly.

#### Possible school closure

You may have heard that a number of local schools had to close briefly last week due to positive COVID-19 cases. If someone in our community tests positive in the future, and has been on the school site in the previous 3 weeks, then the school will close for a day or two for cleaning and contract tracing. Close contacts will have to isolate. To try and reduce numbers of close contacts in such an instance, we have introduced cohorting.

#### Cohorting

Infants (and 2/3S) will work and play separately to primary students, to keep cohorts distinct. Infants students will play in areas A, B and C, while primary students will play in Areas D, E and the library. Where common spaces like the library are used, we wipe down high use areas between groups.

#### **Drop Off**

Please say goodbye to your children at the gate.

#### Ventilation

All rooms will ensure windows are open to allow fresh air to circulate. Air conditioners will still be in use, but in conjunction with the open windows.

#### Year 1 Phonics Screener

Last term we had planned for all children in Year 1 to sit the Phonics Screener. As we were learning from home at this time, we postponed the assessment until Week 5 of this term. In Week 5 each child in Year 1 will sit with their class teacher to participate in a short assessment which will provide information on how your child is progressing in phonics. Each student will be asked to read 40 words aloud which include 20 real words and 20 nonsense words. The assessment includes pseudo or nonsense words to see if the student can use their knowledge of blending to read a word rather than their memory of having seen that word before. If you have any further questions, please talk to your child's class teacher.

#### Beresfield PS Pick-Up Organisation Term 4 2021

Due to COVID restrictions, at pick-up time all parents/caregivers will be asked to wait outside the school grounds. To assist in reducing numbers of parents/caregivers at each gate, K-2 students will be dismissed at different gates. Class teachers in K-2 will walk students to certain gates outlined below.

- Parents: Must stay outside school gates, socially distanced. Once you have collected your child, please do not linger.
- Primary (Years 3-6): will be dismissed from their classroom at 3:00pm and will walk independently to the gate of their choice.
- K-2 students: will be walked to certain gates to meet parents/caregivers at 2:55pm each day.
  - KD, KL and 2/3S will walk to the Boomerang Street gate.
  - 1B and 1D will walk to the Anderson Drive gate.
  - 2M and 2S will walk to Hawthorn Street gate.
- Support classes: that arrive/depart school via transport are to use the usual gates however non taxi students to use the front entrance at Lawson Avenue.

#### Extra information:

Any siblings in K-2: the older sibling will join the class of their younger sibling and will walk out the one gate.
